







Description / Report on Event:

The Electronics and Communication Engineering (ECE) department of **Lakireddy Bali Reddy College of Engineering, Mylavaram**, in association with the **Institution of Electronics and Telecommunication Engineers** (IETE) students' chapter, organized a Circuit Debugging Competition on September 14, 2025, at the Microprocessor and Microcontroller Lab. The event saw enthusiastic participation from III, V, and VII semester ECE students, with a total of 114 batches taking part. The competition aimed to strengthen students' practical knowledge and problem-solving skills by exposing them to real-time circuit faults and troubleshooting challenges.


