 - Suggested to add case studies in “Database Management Systems Lab” course.
 - Suggested to rename the course “Universal Human Values - Understand Harmony and Ethical Human Conduct” as “UHV-II: Understanding Harmony and Ethical Human Conduct”.

- Suggested to merge Course Outcomes (COs) ie., CO-3 & CO-4 of “UHV-II: Understanding Harmony and Ethical Human Conduct”, as both are representing Unit-III.
- Suggested to rename the course “Advanced Data Structures & Algorithms” as “Advanced Data Structures & Algorithms Analysis” as the same course with same syllabus was provided by JNTUK for Computer allied branches with this same name.
- Suggested to refine Unit-V Syllabus of “Advanced Data Structure and Algorithm Analysis” Course to concentrate more on the concepts which are covered in Gate Syllabus.
- Suggested to rename the course “Advanced Data Structures & Algorithms Lab” as “Advanced Data Structures & Algorithms Analysis Lab” as the same course with same syllabus was provided by JNTUK for Computer allied branches with this same name.
- Suggested to remove “Java database connectivity” concept from “Object Oriented Programming through Java” Theory and Lab Courses, as the same concept is being covered in the “Database Management Systems” Theory and Lab Courses offered in the IV semester.
- Suggested to split “Digital Logic & Computer Organization” Course in to two courses like “Digital Logic Design” and “Computer Organization”. But we were unable to accommodate this suggestion, due lake of credits.
- Suggested to replace “Python with DJango” Course by “Full Stack Development-I” as most of the IT Industries are not using “Python with DJango”. Syllabus for “Full Stack Development-I” course is already provided by JNTUK in CSE syllabus. “Python with DJango” Course will be given to the students in the form of workshop, as the same course is being offered by APSSDC in its schedule.
