Before proceeding to Agenda, Chairman has introduced all members. The chairman has started the presentation with the following agenda of items for Information, Consideration, and Ratification/Approval and Suggestions.

- 1. Confirmation of the minutes of 14th Academic Council meeting held on 05-09-2020.
  - > The minutes of 14th Academic Council meeting are confirmed, with the consent of honourable members of Academic council
- 2. Review of Action Taken Report (ATR) on the minutes of 14<sup>th</sup> Academic Council meeting held on 05-09-2020.

The Chairman has presented the Action Taken Report of 14th Academic Council meeting.

- ➤ As suggested by the committee members, challenge valuation has not been included in R20 Regulations. And permission has been accorded to involve internal faculty for revaluation
- As suggested by the committee members, it has been decided to implement the credit shortage promotion policy as per JNTUK guidelines, in R20 regulations.

# 3 (a) Approval of Academic Results of B.Tech (VIII Semester), MBA (IV Semester), MCA (VI Semester), and M.Tech (IV Semester)

The Chairman has presented the results of B.Tech (VIII semester), MBA (IV semester), MCA (VI semester) and M.Tech (IV semester) regular & supplementary examinations of A.Y: 2019-20. The details of the results are as given below.

- > B.Tech (VIII Semester) Regular
  - Aerospace Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 41. Out of which 40 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 97.56 %.
  - Civil Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 60. Out of which 57 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 95.00%.

- Computer Science and Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 127. Out of which 123 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 96.85 %.
- o Electronics and Communication Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 212. Out of which 203 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 95.75 %.
- o Electrical and Electronics Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 133. Out of which 122 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 91.73 %.
- o Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 39. Out of which 36 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 92.31 %.
- o Information Technology: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 61. Out of which 56 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 91.80 %.
- o Mechanical Engineering: Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 194. Out of which 187 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 96.39 %.
- o Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 867. Out of which 824 students have passed the examinations and overall pass percentage is 95.04%.

## ➤ B.Tech (2016-20 Batch) including re-admitted students

- Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 867. Out of which 636 students have been graduated successfully. The percentage of successfully graduated students is 73.36 %.
- Out of 636 graduated students, 378 students graduated without backlogs and 258 with backlogs.
- Out of 636 graduated students, 396 students have secured first class with distinction, 212 students have secured first class and 28 have secured second class.

### MBA (IV Semester) Regular

 Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 112. Out of which 111 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 99.11%.

## MBA (2018-20 Batch)

- o Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 112. Out of which 106 students have been graduated successfully. The percentage of successfully graduated students is 94.64 %.
- Out of 106 graduated students, 101 students graduated without backlogs and 05 with backlogs.
- Out of 106 graduated students, 62 students have secured first class with distinction, 42 students have secured first class and 02 have secured second class

#### > MCA (VI Semester) Regular

Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 51.
 Out of which 51 students have passed the examinations and pass percentage is 100 %.

#### > MCA (2017-20 Batch)

- o Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 51. Out of which 51 students have been graduated successfully. The percentage of successfully graduated students is 100 %.
- Out of 51 graduated students, 47 students graduated without backlogs and 04 with backlogs.
- o Out of 51 graduated students, 29 students have secured first class with distinction and 22 students have secured first class

#### > M.Tech (2018-20 Batch)

- Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 18 out of 24. All the 18 students have been graduated successfully. There are 6 more students, whose graduation is subjected to the completion of backlog subjects and project work.
- Out of 18 graduated students, 16 students have graduated without backlogs and 02 with backlogs.
- o Out of 18 graduated students, 16 students have secured first class with distinction and 2 students have secured first class.

#### ➤ M.Tech (2017-19 Batch)

o Total number of students appeared for the examinations were 02 and graduated successfully. There are 5 more students, whose graduation is subjected to the completion of backlog subjects and project work.

**Decision:** The results of B.Tech (VIII semester), MBA (IV semester), MCA (VI semester) and M.Tech (IV semester) regular & supplementary examinations of A.Y: 2019-20 have been approved by the honorable members of Academic Council

## 3 (c) Discussion and Approval of Guidelines for B. Tech Honors and Minor programmes- R20 Regulations

The following are the Guidelines for B. Tech Honours and Minor programmes- of R20 Regulations

- A student has to acquire additional 20 credits. (04 courses with 04 credits + 04 credits through MOOCS).
- A student shall register for Honors/Minors program at the beginning of 4<sup>th</sup> semester (8.0 SGPA up to 2<sup>nd</sup> semester without any backlogs)
- ➤ His/Her registration for Honors/Minors Programme stands cancelled and he/she shall continue with the regular Programme if SGPA of 3<sup>rd</sup> semester is less than 8.0.
- ➤ Honors/Minors degree will be awarded if he/she maintains 8.0 SGPA in every semester without backlogs.

**Decision:** Approved

## 3(d) Discussion and Approval of assessment tools for attainment of Program Educational Objectives (PEOs)

The following are the assessment tools for attainment for PEOs

- ➤ PEOs will be calculated after 04 to 05 years of graduation PEO attainment is based on stakeholder inputs using an online survey questionnaire
- ➤ Direct Assessment (30%): POs-PEOs Articulation
- > Indirect Assessment (70%): Employer Survey (40%), Alumni Survey (30%)
