# 3. Information on College Accreditations and Rankings.

# a) NBA

The Aerospace and Civil Engineering departments have successfully achieved NBA Accreditation for a three-year period, from A.Y. 2023-24 to 2025-26. With these accreditations, all seven eligible UG programs (ASE, CE, CSE, IT, ECE, EEE, and ME) are accredited by NBA under Tier-I. Additionally, the NBA expert team has already conducted their visit to PG program MBA, and we are currently awaiting the result.

### b) Extension of Autonomous Status

UGC has extended Autonomous status for 10 years, i.e., up to A.Y. 2032-33 and the same is conferred by JNTUK Kakinada.

#### c) NIRF India Rankings 2023

The college has secured a position in the Rank band of 101-150 in NIRF India Rankings 2023 under the Innovation Category.

### Decision:

The hon'ble members appreciated the efforts of the Principal, Staff, and Students for achieving NBA accreditation under Tier-I and for securing a position in the NIRF India Rankings 2023 under Innovation.

### 4. Approval of R23 Regulations (UG & PG).

❖ The committee has suggested that R23 Regulations will be applicable to students readmitted in the first year, first semester based on the interest of the students and suggested that an Undertaking Form is to be collected from both students and parents prior to their re-joining into current Regulations and other members also approved the same.

# 8. Information on students detained due to shortage of Attendance for the A.Y.:2022-23 (B.Tech. -II Sem).

The chairman has presented the total of 13 students those were detained, consisting of 9 undergraduate (UG) students pursuing B.Tech.in various branches (CE-1, CSE-2, CSE (AI&ML)-1, ECE-1, EEE-1, IT-1, ME-2) and 4 postgraduate (MBA) students.

#### **Decision**:

- The academic departments responsible for these students would reach out to them individually to understand the reasons for their attendance issues.
- The members advised to conduct counselling sessions and mentoring programs to help these students improve their attendance in the upcoming semesters.

# 9. Information on students detained due to shortage of Credits for promotion to B.Tech. V & VII semesters for the A.Y.: 2023-24.

The chairman has presented a total of 7 undergraduate (UG) students who were detained due to a shortage of credits. This group comprises 6 students from various branches (CE-1, CSE-1, EEE-1, IT-1, ME-2) who were not promoted to the V Semester and 1 student from the ME branch who was not promoted to the VII Semester.

#### **Decision:**

The committee has suggested conducting remedial classes to help students overcome credit shortages, enabling them to meet the eligibility requirements for promotion to the next semester.

# 10. Any other point with the permission of Chair.

- ➤ Prof. A. Venu Gopal garu suggested the inclusion of Program Outcomes (POs) for PG programs, and this suggestion was duly approved. Additionally, he recommended adhering to the university's guidelines regarding the swapping of institutions by students in accordance with the R23 Regulations.
- ➤ M.S.R. Murthy garu suggested raising awareness among non-IT students about pathways to enter the software industry and emphasized exploring job opportunities in core companies for ME, CE, EEE, and ECE students. He also acknowledged our impressive placement track record and recommended including data on placement cell registrations and successful placements for a more comprehensive overview of our placement efforts.
- ➤ Re-joining of the Students into I B.Tech. I Semester: Prof. B. Bala Krishna garu and Prof. K. Venkata Reddy garu advised that the R23 Regulations will be applicable to students readmitted in the first year, first semester based on the interest of the students and suggested that an Undertaking Form is to be collected from both students and parents prior to their re-joining into current Regulations and other members also approved the same.

- The committee has suggested to print the Month & Year of Pass in the Memorandum of Grades, Consolidated Grade Cards, Provisional Certificates etc as per the first subject conducted month & year of examinations for a particular semester (i.e., the month which is mentioned in the examination issued notification). This will be applicable for all the UG & PG regular & supplementary semester end examinations conducted from January 2024 onwards.
- > The Chairman has presented the information of training by PEGA and placements in TCS.
- > The Chairman presented the few remarkable following achievements of students to the members.
  - K. Sai Venkata Supraja, IV. B.Tech. ECE got 2<sup>nd</sup> place in State level "Best Student Award" Presented by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Andhra Pradesh Sri. Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy on 20-06-2023.
  - K. Ruby, III B. Tech. ASE got Appreciation Certificate from Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, JNTUK, Kakinada for getting AIR – 652 in GATE 2023.
  - 83 Students from various department have received the North South Foundation (NSF) scholarship worth of Rs. 20.75 Lakhs.

- > Approval of AQAR of the A.Y.: 2022-23 is discussed and approved.
