b) NIRF India Rankings 2023

- ➤ The Registration of our institution for NIRF-2023 (8th Edition) under Engineering, Research and Overall categories has been completed on 04th Nov. 2022.
- As Data Capturing System (DCS) is opened on 28th Nov. 2022, the collection of information pertaining to different parameters of NIRF Application is under process and likely to submit well before the deadline 06th Jan. 2023 given by NIRF.
- The Chairman has presented the comparison of data on Publications, Citations and Patents of our institution during the last three NIRF-2022, 2021 & 2020 Indian Rankings and emphasized the improvement in R&D accomplishments.
