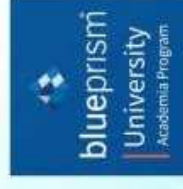
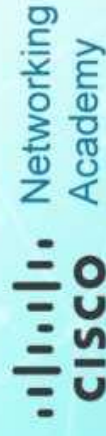

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN

EduSkills Foundation ("EduSkills")

AND

Lakireddy Bali Reddy College of Engineering

FOR EDUSKILLS MEMBERSHIP PROGRAM

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is effective from the date of signatures below ("Effective Date"); hereinafter, each a "Party" or together, "the Parties". EduSkills will be referred as 'First party' and other party will be referred as 'Second party'.

The Parties have been discussing a proposed collaboration in the area of "Skill Development, IT Education and Workforce Development Programs" ("Collaboration Areas").

Now the Parties agree as follows:

A. NON-BINDING TERMS.

The Parties understand that MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the parties with respect to the principal terms of the proposed collaboration.

The Parties understand that this MOU is intended only to summarize the current understanding of the Parties with respect to the Collaboration Areas and to facilitate their further discussions regarding certain objectives of the proposed partnership, as more fully described in Exhibit A, which are non-binding on the Parties. The terms and objectives set forth in Exhibit A shall be used for discussion purposes only and shall not be deemed to create any rights or obligations for or on behalf of any Party.

B. BINDING TERMS

The Parties hereby acknowledge and agree that the following subsections under this Section B (Binding Terms) shall be binding and create legal rights and obligations on the Parties.

1. Confidentiality

In this MOU "Confidential Information" means any information or data, irrespective of the form and nature thereof, that is material to the Party disclosing such information ("Discloser") to the other Party ("Recipient"), including, but not limited to technical know how, specifications, designs, models, software, techniques, drawings, processes, as well as industrial and intellectual property rights, business information, trade secrets, customer lists, financial information, process, costs, sales and marketing plans, information posted on their respective websites or any other information with the Recipient knows or reasonably ought to know is confidential, proprietary or trade secret information of the Discloser.

The Recipient shall at all times, both during the term of this MOU and for a period of at least three (3) years after its expiration or termination, keep in trust and confidence all such Confidential Information, and shall not use such Confidential Information other than for the purpose of fulfilling its obligations under this MOU, nor shall the Recipient disclose any such Confidential Information to any third party without the Disclosing Party's prior written consent. Upon termination of this MOU or written request from the Discloser, the Recipient shall, within fifteen (15) days from such termination or request, return all Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof to the Discloser, or at the Discloser's option, destroy the Confidential Information and any and all copies thereof, and certify such destruction

The obligations of confidentiality set forth herein shall not apply to information which;

- a. Was rightfully in possession of or known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality prior to receiving it from the Discloser;
- b. Is, or subsequently becomes, legally and publicly available without breach of this MOU;

- c. Is rightfully obtained by the Recipient from a source other than the Discloser, without any obligation of confidentiality; or
- d. Is developed by or for the Recipient without use of the Confidential Information.

The Recipient may only disclose Confidential Information pursuant to a valid order issued by a court or governmental agency, provided that the Recipient provides the Discloser:

- a. Prior written notice of such obligation; and
- b. The opportunity to oppose such disclosure or obtain a protective order.

The Confidential Information shall remain the property of the Discloser and no license to any existing or future intellectual property rights or Confidential Information is granted or implied under this MOU.

All Confidential Information is provided "AS IS". The Discloser shall not be liable for any inaccuracy or completeness of the Confidential Information, nor are there any express or implied representations or warranties by either party to the other, including with respect to the infringement of any intellectual property rights or any right of privacy, or any rights of third persons.

2. Scope

The scope of this MOU does not cover any development work, testing, licensing, distribution, support, sales, or maintenance. Should the Parties decide to pursue such matter that is outside the scope of this MOU, the Parties shall enter into a development, license, distribution, or other appropriate written agreement(s) accordingly.

3. Publicity

The Parties hereby agree that no press release or other public announcements regarding this MOU or any agreements contemplated thereby shall be made without prior review and written agreement signed by a duly authorized representative of the other Party.

4. Term and Termination

The Parties agree that this MOU shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue in effect until the earliest occurrence of one of the following: (1) the execution of a definitive MOU or definitive agreement relating to the scope of this MOU; (2) written notice by one Party to the other of termination of this MOU; or **thirty six (36) months** from the Effective Date of this MOU. Section B (including all subsections) shall survive any termination of this MOU. Upon expiry of the Term, it is the intention of the Parties to further progress the solutions initiated under this MOU towards overall achievement of the objectives and outcomes contemplated herein. Second party shall, to this extent, endeavor to continue maintaining and promoting such solutions and projects to further the objectives set forth in the MOU.

5. Limitation of Liability

Except for liability relating to either Party's breach of the other Party's confidential information or intellectual property rights, in no event shall either Party be liable to the other Party for any direct, indirect, incidental, special, punitive or consequential damages or loss of profits, lost revenue or loss of data.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in this MOU shall limit the Parties liability for bodily injury or death caused by its negligence or its liability in the tort of deceit.

6. Intellectual property rights

Each Party will retain the exclusive rights, title and ownership of all its pre-existing Intellectual Property, Confidential Information and materials (including, without limitation, proprietary ideas, sketches, diagrams, text, know-how, concepts, proofs of concepts, artwork, software, algorithms, methods, processes, identifier codes or other technology) owned or developed by such Party.

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7. Governing laws and jurisdiction

The Parties shall make efforts in good faith to amicably resolve all disputes as may arise out of or in connection with this MOU. This MOU shall be subject to and governed by the laws of India and the Indian courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any claim arising under this MOU. Notwithstanding the foregoing, either Party may seek interim injunctive relief in any court of appropriate jurisdiction with respect to any alleged breach of such Party's intellectual property or proprietary rights.

8. Costs

Unless otherwise agreed upon in writing, each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses arising in connection with this MOU and the possible negotiations, completion and implementation of definitive Agreements if any, including but not limited to costs of experts, consultants, lawyers and travel expenses.

9. Amendment

This MOU may be amended at any time by the mutual written assent of the Parties.

10. Severability.

Should any portion of this MOU be determined to be illegal or unenforceable, the remainder of the MOU shall continue in full force and effect, and either party may renegotiate the terms affected by the severance.

EXHIBIT A**NON-BINDING TERMS****1. Scope and Intent**

EduSkills and Lakireddy Bali Reddy College of Engineering have decided to work together for the purpose of expanding digital skills into higher education system through offering various world class technical programs in Networking, Cybersecurity, Cloud computing, automation, RPA and other industry 4.0 skills to the colleges and their students.

2. Proposed Obligations of Second party

- To create awareness for adoption and registration of technical courses from interested students
- To nominate a point of contact who could monitor and review the program updates
- To ensure following pre-requisites to be followed by the participating colleges:
 - a. High speed broadband connectivity, computer labs for relevant courses and classroom IT set-up for all participating institutions.
 - b. Identify upto 2 (Two) Educators with required qualification like Engineers/MCA in Computer Science/IT/Electronics, etc. or experienced diploma holders to receive Training of Trainers for each academy program.
 - c. Pay membership fee on annual basis for next 3 years. Following year's membership fee can be incremented on nominal basis, if the need arises. **Agreement to be renewed after 3 years.**

3. Proposed obligations of EduSkills:

- a. To offer digital content and courses of up to 5 global academy programs to its member institution.
- b. To offer LMS of the academy programs, where ever applicable.
- c. To offer branding collaterals access and usage of academy programs.
- d. 'Train the Trainers' to the nominated educators by the institution.
- e. Virtual orientation session/workshop for the institution.
- f. In-person/remote support for any troubleshooting needed during the onboarding process.
- g. To offer opportunities to participate in job fairs, seminars, conferences and any regional/national/global competitions or platforms for the students, educators and/or institution's leadership.

4. Annual Membership Fee

- Year 1: INR 40,000 + Training fee + GST
- Year 2: INR 40,000* + GST
- Year 3: INR 40,000* + GST

* Can be incremented annually on a very nominal basis.

Please Note: This fee applies on institutions. EduSkills will not charge any fee from the students as these programs comes under purview of CSR. Institutions may enroll and extend benefit to as many students they want. No capping on number of students.

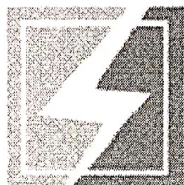

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) made on the First day of February Two Thousand Twenty between the Lakireddy BaliReddy College of Engineering (Autonomous), Mylavaram-521 230, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh represented by the Principal of the College, hereinafter referred to as "LBRCE" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successor in office or assign) of the one part

And

the G. S. Electricals, 221, Block B-10, New Autonagar, Kanuru, Vijayawada 520 007, Andhra Pradesh An ISO 9001 – 2015 certified company represented by the Proprietor hereinafter referred to as "G S Transformers" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successor in office or assign) of the other part.

It is hereby agreed and declared that for providing academic support covering training programmes, guest lectures and projects at LBRCE and G S Transformers, the following will be responsibilities and rights of LBRCE and G S Transformers.

SCOPE OF WORK

LBRCE(Autonomous) is an Engineering College established in 1998 in Mylavaram is running 5 M.Tech, plus MBA and MCA post graduate programmes, under graduate programmes in 8 disciplines. G S Transformers is a company pioneer in manufacturing of instrument and distribution transformers operating from Vijayawada. Both LBRCE and G S Transformers are desirous to enter into an agreement covering joint efforts leading towards dissemination of knowledge, seminars, workshops, etc., having exchange of experts amongst one another, organizing visits of students, internships, arranging placements, etc. in the areas of Electrical Engineering and Management.

PROVISIONS OF THE MoU

1. For successful implementation of the provisions envisaged in this MoU, a group consisting of members from LBRCE and G S Transformers, under the joint Chairmanship of the HOD/EEE, LBRCE and Proprietor, G S Transformers will be constituted to oversee the functional aspects and formulate future plans.
2. Augmentation of the technical infrastructure, training and software development and as agreed upon during the course of implementation of this MoU will be decided by the group.
3. G S Transformers and LBRCE will jointly work out, the Annual Action Plan for subsequent years with respect to the areas of engineering and management, including additional resources required and the payment schedules, if any involved, primarily for:
 - a. Exchange of experts leading to special invited/expert lectures by members, conduct of short term training programmes, etc.
 - b. Students' visits to the facilities,
 - c. Students' internships, and
 - d. Placement of students
4. The quantum of work, costing and time frame for completing specific projects and activities will be submitted under the Project proposal of LBRCE and G S Transformers on project-to-project or activity-to-activity basis.
5. If the proposal is approved by the group, LBRCE and G S Transformers will arrange for all financial support, as the case may be at their end, for arranging trainings, or providing other services to the other on project-to-project basis as per the agreed expenses.

6. LBRCE and G S Transformers will respect the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of one another and will ensure that nothing is released/revealed without the consent of other party.

7. Rights of IPR developed during the period of association between the organizations (including faculty members and students) will be governed by the rules of host organization unless otherwise specified by an alternative agreement.

8. Whenever one party receives any information from the other under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the IPR received.

9. Training at different levels of personnel on relevant aspects will be arranged at mutually agreed centres.

10. The research outcomes to be developed by students and faculty members will have joint ownership of G S Transformers and LBRCE.

11. The procurement of hardware, equipment and system software can be made by respective parties either themselves or on the request of the other party through their own procurement channel and procedure.

12. LBRCE and G.S.Transformers will jointly participate in commercialization of the equipment, products or systems thus developed under this MoU, and based on the team composition shall have agreeable rights to the proceeds generated/ received from the said commercialization. Patents, copyrights, trademarks, and/or IPR of such equipment or systems shall also be in joint names of both parties.

13. G S Transformers and LBRCE hereto acknowledge that this MoU is only a brief statement of the intentions of the parties herein with regard to the areas in which the activities are sought and the parties agree that the terms and conditions in respect of the precise scope and extent work to be carried out and manner of execution of such work under each area shall be incorporated by way of a separate correspondence to be exchanged between the parties in relation to above said matters shall be governed by the terms and conditions embodied in the correspondence with regard to the above said areas.

14. All the departments/locations of LBRCE and G S Transformers will be covered for providing academic/research support to each other.

15. The required services towards establishing new facilities will be provided within the ambit of technical feasibility and resource constraints. This will include the requirements indicated by one other from time to time.

16. This MoU does not deem to establish a relationship with the other that would create situation of employing other's personnel, without specific written clearance from the authorized signatories.

17. Both parties will respect information propriety of one another and will provide all mutually agreed safeguards, which are feasible within the ambit of technical feasibility and resources constraints.

18. Both parties will try to organize/conduct at least one seminar/lecture for each related engineering programme in a semester towards one or more areas of awareness/ popularizing systems, technology and management sectors.

19. A party will not be sued in any Court of Law for being unable to provide any activity, due to unforeseen circumstances or natural calamity beyond its control.

20. If the circumstances as referred in clause 19 above warrant a discontinuance of this MoU, either by LBRCE or by G S Transformers, with one of the party decides to discontinue its service, the equipment of one party installed at the other's locations will be taken back. G S Transformers and LBRCE will mutually decide such discontinuance of the facility, without any financial or administrative liabilities to each other. The decision to discontinue the services would be implemented from a date mutually agreed upon.

21. On all aspects where the above articles of understanding are silent, or for special cases of deviation from these articles, the decision mutually agreed between G S Transformers and LBRCE will be final. However, in case of any dispute relating to or arising out of MoU, such dispute will be resolved amicably by mutual consultations.

22. This MoU will be in force initially for a period of five years from the date of its signing until terminated/discontinued by any party under clause 20 above. The term of this MoU can be extended further on the terms as may be mutually agreed by the parties hereto.

This MoU Regarding LabVIEW Academy Program ("MoU") is made by and between Lakireddy Balireddy College of Engineering, having the campus at Mylavaram, Andhra Pradesh represented by its Director, Dr.E.V.Prasad, ("LBRCE") and NI Systems (India) Pvt. Ltd. ("NI"), a company incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956 of India, having its registered office at 81/1 & 82/1, Salarpuria Softzone, Wing B, 5th Floor, Block A, Bellandur, Varthur Hobli, Bangalore 560 037 represented by **Mr. Solaikutty Dhanabal**, Academic Manager, effective as of 21st September, 2016 (the "Effective Date").

1. **Institution; Courses.** Institution warrants and represents that it is a degree-granting educational institution. During the Term (as defined below), Institution agrees to offer and conduct courses for academic purposes at Institution's facilities, in a professional manner, teaching the use of the NI LabVIEW software, which courses must not be for commercial, corporate or "customer" training purposes and must (a) be taught by an instructor who is then currently a Certified LabVIEW Associate Developer (the Certified LabVIEW Associate Developer certificate needs to be updated every two years) who regularly teaches degree-fulfilling or continuing education courses to students enrolled in or taking continuing education courses at Institution ("Instructor"); (b) include at least 30 hours of instruction specifically directed to the use of the LabVIEW software; (c) be provided in accordance with a course syllabus reviewed and approved by NI; and (d) otherwise meet requirements provided or made available by NI to Institution from time to time (the "Courses"). Institution shall ensure no courses offered or provided are taught or introduced at the Institution which directly competes against the Courses.

2. **Materials.** Institution agrees to set up a NI LabVIEW Academy in field of Virtual Instrumentation, (hereinafter referred to as ACADEMY). NI agrees to provide to Institution the "Instructional Materials" identified on Exhibit A (the "Materials") solely for the purpose of Institution's teaching the Courses at ACADEMY and under the below conditions:

2.1. Subject to, and conditioned on Institution's compliance with, the terms of this MoU, NI hereby grants to Institution, and Institution hereby accepts, a nonexclusive, nontransferable, limited license, for the Term (as defined below) only, to (a) use the Materials for the sole purpose of teaching the Courses, (b) provide the Materials only to those students enrolled (or taking continuing education classes) at Institution and who are taking the Courses ("Students"), except that Institution may not provide to any Students, or to any persons or entities other than Instructors, any Materials which are designated on Exhibit A as "Instructor Use Only", and (c) make a reasonable number of copies of only those Materials which are identified on Exhibit A as "Copying Permitted for Course Use", but only as necessary for the purpose set forth in this Subsection 2.1.

2.2. Institution hereby agrees not to itself, and not to encourage or assist Students or others to, (a) copy or reproduce any Materials except as expressly permitted in Subsection 2.1, (b) transfer, disseminate or distribute any Materials to any third-party, except Students to the extent expressly permitted in Subsection 2.1, or (c) use any Materials for any purpose other than the Courses. On any termination or expiration of this MoU, if NI requests, Institution shall, at Institution's sole cost and expense, return to NI all Materials identified on Exhibit A as "Instructor Use Only".

3. **Required Software Products Not Included.** Institution agrees to obtain from NI, at Institution's sole cost and expense, the necessary Academic Teaching Licenses (as described in the applicable National Instruments Software License MoU, available at http://www.ni.com/pdf/legal/us/software_license_agreement.pdf) to use the LabVIEW software in conducting the Courses; and to obtain from NI, or cause each of the Students to so obtain, at their sole cost and expense, the necessary Student Edition Licenses (as described in the applicable National Instruments Software License MoU) to use the LabVIEW software in the Courses. Institution agrees to comply with, and to cause the Students to comply with, such licenses, including without limitation ensuring that the licensed software is not used for any research, commercial, industrial, or other purpose prohibited by the applicable National Instruments Software License MoU. Except as may be expressly modified by this MoU, the terms and conditions of the

applicable National Instruments Software License MoUs govern Institution's, and the Instructors' and Students', uses of the LabVIEW software as related to the LabVIEW Academy Program and the Course.

4. Required Textbooks and Equipment Not Included. Institution further agrees to obtain and provide, at Institution's sole cost and expense, or to cause each of the Students to so obtain, at their sole cost and expense, textbooks acceptable to NI for use in the Course, as well as any hardware and software as required for the Course, and other appropriate National Instruments equipment approved by NI. Such textbooks, hardware, software and National Instruments equipment approved by NI must be obtained separately and are subject to separate charges.

5. Name, Logo, and Trademarks.

5.1. Subject to, and conditioned on Institution's compliance with, the terms of this MoU, NI hereby grants to Institution, and Institution hereby accepts, a nonexclusive, nontransferable, limited license, for the Term (as defined below) only, to display the "LabVIEW Academy" Logo identified on Exhibit B hereto, the "LabVIEW Academy" name, any and all trademarks of NI therein, including without limitation, "LabVIEW", "National Instruments", and the "LabVIEW" logo design, only as part of, and as each appears in, the "LabVIEW Academy" Logo or the "LabVIEW Academy" name as the case may be (such trademarks being referred to as the "Marks"), solely in connection with providing, selling, promoting and advertising the Courses, solely on web site displays, printed literature, and other materials acceptable to NI and which are of an acceptable level of quality determined by NI in NI's sole discretion, and solely in accordance with Exhibit B hereto and any and all other guidelines and instructions provided or made available by NI to Institution from time to time. In no event may Institution display or use any Mark except as part of, and as it appears in, the "LabVIEW Academy" Logo or the "LabVIEW Academy" name as the case may be.

5.2. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, Institution shall not during the term of this MoU or thereafter:

- (b) take any action that may tend to imply or express that Institution is the owner of any Mark or that Licensee has any right, title or interest in ownership or usage in any Mark;

- (d) misuse any Mark;

INSTITUTION ACKNOWLEDGES AND AGREES THAT THE LICENSES, MATERIALS AND INFORMATION PROVIDED BY NI ARE AND WILL BE PROVIDED ON AN "AS IS" BASIS AND WITHOUT WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, AND NO WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, ARE MADE WITH RESPECT TO SUCH LICENSES, MATERIALS OR INFORMATION, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, TITLE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, OR ANY OTHER WARRANTIES THAT MAY OTHERWISE ARISE FROM USAGE OF TRADE OR COURSE OF DEALING; ANY AND ALL OF WHICH IMPLIED AND STATUTORY WARRANTIES ARE HEREBY DISCLAIMED, TO THE FULL EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW.

8. Term and Termination.

8.1. Term. This MoU shall commence on the Effective Date and continue for thirty six (36) months unless terminated earlier. Either party may notify the other party in writing of early termination of this MoU by a prior notice of not less than three months prior to the effect of such termination.

8.2 Termination. Notwithstanding Section 8.1, if, during this MoU, including renewal terms, either party breaches this MoU, the other party may terminate this MoU upon notice to such party if such breach has not been cured to the reasonable satisfaction of the other party within thirty (30) days following written notice of the breach. This MoU shall terminate immediately and automatically if the Institution suspends operations, is or becomes the subject any bankruptcy or similar proceeding, makes an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or is adjudicated bankrupt or insolvent.

8.3 Effect. The following sections and subsections shall survive any termination or expiration of this MoU: 2.2, 5.3, 5.4, 6, 7, 8.3, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15.

9. INDEMNITY; LIMITED LIABILITY.

9.1 Indemnity By Institution. NI shall not be liable for a settlement made without its prior written consent. This Subsection 9.2 states Institution's sole remedy for, and NI's entire liability and responsibility for, infringement of any patent, trademark, copyright, or other intellectual or industrial property right relating to the Materials. **THIS LIMITED INDEMNITY IS IN LIEU OF ANY OTHER STATUTORY OR IMPLIED WARRANTY OR REMEDY AGAINST INFRINGEMENT.**

All notices which shall be given by either party under the terms of this MoU shall be in writing and be hand delivered, sent by facsimile transmission, overnight delivery, or sent by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the receiving party at the address listed at the first page or to such other persons or addresses as may be designated by a party in writing. Notice shall be effective on the date it is received or receipt is confirmed or, if mailed as described above, no later than ten (10) days after the date of such mailing.

14. Compliance with Laws. Institution agrees to comply with all applicable laws, including without limitation United States export laws and regulations, in Institution's performance of, and exercise of rights under, this MoU.

15. Registration. If this MoU is required to be registered with authorities in India, Institution shall complete any such required procedures promptly.





- c) The space and other infrastructure facilities will be provided by Party B.




PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) made on the **Twenty ninth day of July Two Thousand Fifteen** between the **Lakireddy BaliReddy College of Engineering (Autonomous), Mylavaram-521 230, Krishna District, Andhra Pradesh** represented by the Director of the College, hereinafter referred to as "LBRCE" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successor in office or assign) of the one part

And

the **G. S. Electricals, 221, Block B-10, New Autonagar, Kanuru, Vijayawada 520 007, Andhra Pradesh** represented by the Manager hereinafter referred to as "GSE" (which expression shall unless excluded by or repugnant to the context be deemed to include his successor in office or assign) of the other part.

It is hereby agreed and declared that for providing academic support covering training programmes, guest lectures and projects at LBRCE and GSE, the following will be responsibilities and rights of LBRCE and GSE.

SCOPE OF WORK

LBRCE(Autonomous) is an Engineering College established in 1998 in Mylavaram is running 5 M.Tech, plus MBA and MCA post graduate programmes, and under graduate programmes in 8 disciplines. GSE is a company pioneer in manufacturing of instrument and distribution transformers operating from Vijayawada. Both LBRCE and GSE are desirous to enter into an agreement covering joint efforts leading towards dissemination of knowledge, seminars, workshops, etc., having exchange of experts amongst one another, organizing visits of students, internships, arranging placements, etc. in the areas of Electrical Engineering and Management.

PROVISIONS OF THE MoU

1. For successful implementation of the provisions envisaged in this MoU, a group consisting of members from LBRCE and GSE, under the joint Chairmanship of the HOD/EEE, LBRCE and Manager, GSE will be constituted to oversee the functional aspects and formulate future plans.
2. Augmentation of the technical infrastructure, training and software development and as agreed upon during the course of implementation of this MoU will be decided by the group.
3. GSE and LBRCE will jointly work out, the Annual Action Plan for subsequent years with respect to the areas of engineering and management, including additional resources required and the payment schedules, if any involved, primarily for:
 - a. Exchange of experts leading to special invited/expert lectures by members, conduct of short term training programmes, etc.
 - b. Students' visits to the facilities,
 - c. Students' internships, and
 - d. Placement of students
4. The quantum of work, costing and time frame for completing specific projects and activities will be submitted under the Project proposal of LBRCE and GSE on project-to-project or activity-to-activity basis.
5. If the proposal is approved by the group, LBRCE and GSE will arrange for all financial support, as the case may be at their end, for arranging trainings, or providing other services to the other on project-to-project basis as per the agreed expenses.

6. LBRCE and GSE will respect the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of one another and will ensure that nothing is released/revealed without the consent of other party.
7. Rights of IPR developed during the period of association between the organizations (including faculty members and students) will be governed by the rules of host organization unless otherwise specified by an alternative agreement.
8. Whenever one party receives any information from the other under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the IPR received.
9. Training at different levels of personnel on relevant aspects will be arranged at mutually agreed centres.
10. The research outcomes to be developed by students and faculty members will have joint ownership of GSE and LBRCE.
11. The procurement of hardware, equipment and system software can be made by respective parties either themselves or on the request of the other party through their own procurement channel and procedure.
12. LBRCE and GSE will jointly participate in commercialization of the equipment, products or systems thus developed under this MoU, and based on the team composition shall have agreeable rights to the proceeds generated/ received from the said commercialization. Patents, copyrights, trademarks, and/or IPR of such equipment or systems shall also be in joint names of both parties.
13. GSE and LBRCE hereto acknowledge that this MoU is only a brief statement of the intentions of the parties herein with regard to the areas in which the activities are sought and the parties agree that the terms and conditions in respect of the precise scope and extent work to be carried out and manner of execution of such work under each area shall be incorporated by way of a separate correspondence to be exchanged between the parties in relation to above said matters shall be governed by the terms and conditions embodied in the correspondence with regard to the above said areas.
14. All the departments/locations of LBRCE and GSE will be covered for providing academic/research support to each other.
15. The required services towards establishing new facilities will be provided within the ambit of technical feasibility and resource constraints. This will include the requirements indicated by one other from time to time.

16. This MoU does not deem to establish a relationship with the other that would create situation of employing other's personnel, without specific written clearance from the authorized signatories.

17. Both parties will respect information propriety of one another and will provide all mutually agreed safeguards, which are feasible within the ambit of technical feasibility and resources constraints.

18. Both parties will try to organize/conduct at least one seminar/lecture for each related engineering programme in a semester towards one or more areas of awareness/ popularizing systems, technology and management sectors.

19. A party will not be sued in any Court of Law for being unable to provide any activity, due to unforeseen circumstances or natural calamity beyond its control.

20. If the circumstances as referred in clause 19 above warrant a discontinuance of this MoU, either by LBRCE or by GSE, with one of the party decides to discontinue its service, the equipment of one party installed at the other's locations will be taken back. GSE and LBRCE will mutually decide such discontinuance of the facility, without any financial or administrative liabilities to each other. The decision to discontinue the services would be implemented from a date mutually agreed upon.

21. On all aspects where the above articles of understanding are silent, or for special cases of deviation from these articles, the decision mutually agreed between GSE and LBRCE will be final. However, in case of any dispute relating to or arising out of MoU, such dispute will be resolved amicably by mutual consultations.

22. This MoU will be in force initially for a period of five years from the date of its signing until terminated/discontinued by any party under clause 20 above. The term of this MoU can be extended further on the terms as may be mutually agreed by the parties hereto.

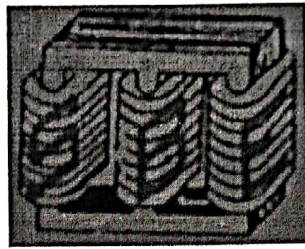

2. Augmentation of the technical infrastructure, training and software development and as agreed upon during the course of implementation of this MoU will be decided by the group.
3. SBE and LBRCE will jointly work out, the Annual Action Plan for subsequent years with respect to the areas of engineering and management, including additional resources required and the payment schedules, if any involved, primarily for:
 - a. Exchange of experts leading to special invited/expert lectures by members, conduct of short term training programmes, etc.
 - b. Students' visits to the facilities,
 - c. Students' internships, and
 - d. Placement of students
4. The quantum of work, costing and time frame for completing specific projects and activities will be submitted under the Project proposal of LBRCE and SBE on project-to-project or activity-to-activity basis.
5. If the proposal is approved by the group, LBRCE and SBE will arrange for all financial support, as the case may be at their end, for arranging trainings, or providing other services to the other on project-to-project basis as per the agreed expenses.

6. LBRCE and SBE will respect the Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) of one another and will ensure that nothing is released/revealed without the consent of other party.
7. Rights of IPR developed during the period of association between the organizations (including faculty members and students) will be governed by the rules of host organization unless otherwise specified by an alternative agreement.
8. Whenever one party receives any information from the other under a clearly defined non-disclosure agreement, necessary steps will be taken to protect the IPR received.
9. Training at different levels of personnel on relevant aspects will be arranged at mutually agreed centres.
10. The research outcomes to be developed by students and faculty members will have joint ownership of SBE and LBRCE.
11. The procurement of hardware, equipment and system software can be made by respective parties either themselves or on the request of the other party through their own procurement channel and procedure.
12. LBRCE and SBE will jointly participate in commercialization of the equipment, products or systems thus developed under this MoU, and based on the team composition shall have agreeable rights to the proceeds generated/ received from the said commercialization. Patents, copyrights, trademarks, and/or IPR of such equipment or systems shall also be in joint names of both parties.
13. SBE and LBRCE hereto acknowledge that this MoU is only a brief statement of the intentions of the parties herein with regard to the areas in which the activities are sought and the parties agree that the terms and conditions in respect of the precise scope and extent work to be carried out and manner of execution of such work under each area shall be incorporated by way of a separate correspondence to be exchanged between the parties in relation to above said matters shall be governed by the terms and conditions embodied in the correspondence with regard to the above said areas.
14. All the departments/locations of LBRCE and SBE will be covered for providing academic/research support to each other.
15. The required services towards establishing new facilities will be provided within the ambit of technical feasibility and resource constraints. This will include the requirements indicated by one other from time to time.

16. This MoU does not deem to establish a relationship with the other that would create situation of employing other's personnel, without specific written clearance from the authorized signatories.

17. Both parties will respect information propriety of one another and will provide all mutually agreed safeguards, which are feasible within the ambit of technical feasibility and resources constraints.

18. Both parties will try to organize/conduct at least one seminar/lecture for each related engineering programme in a semester towards one or more areas of awareness/ popularizing systems, technology and management sectors.

19. A party will not be sued in any Court of Law for being unable to provide any activity, due to unforeseen circumstances or natural calamity beyond its control.

20. If the circumstances as referred in clause 19 above warrant a discontinuance of this MoU, either by LBRCE or by SBE, with one of the party decides to discontinue its service, the equipment of one party installed at the other's locations will be taken back. SBE and LBRCE will mutually decide such discontinuance of the facility, without any financial or administrative liabilities to each other. The decision to discontinue the services would be implemented from a date mutually agreed upon.

21. On all aspects where the above articles of understanding are silent, or for special cases of deviation from these articles, the decision mutually agreed between SBE and LBRCE will be final. However, in case of any dispute relating to or arising out of MoU, such dispute will be resolved amicably by mutual consultations.

22. This MoU will be in force initially for a period of five years from the date of its signing until terminated/discontinued by any party under clause 20 above. The term of this MoU can be extended further on the terms as may be mutually agreed by the parties hereto.
