Policy statement:

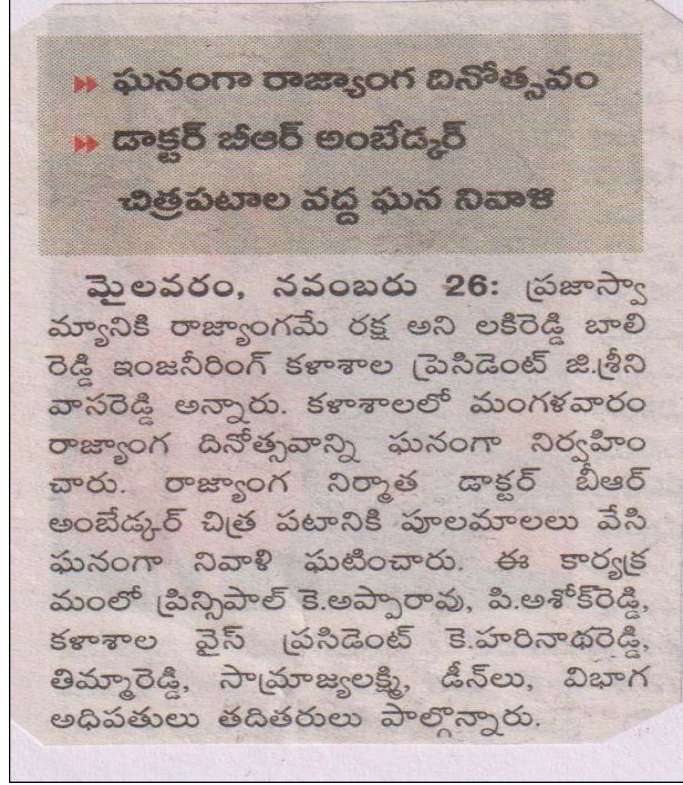
