Detailed Minutes of the Meeting:

The Meeting has started by the chairman of BOS at 11.00 AM and discussed the following points:

1. The minutes of the 19th BOS meeting held on 14-10-2025 were reviewed and confirmed without any modifications.
2. The Action Taken Report (ATR) of the 19th BOS meeting was presented and discussed. The committee noted the progress on the action points from the previous meeting and approved the report.
3. Members discussed and reviewed the syllabi and course structure of the R24 Regulation, including specification of Course Outcomes (COs) and CO-PO articulation matrix. The committee suggested incorporating more industry-oriented and skill-based components wherever necessary. The Board approved the syllabi and course structure of R24 Regulation.
4. Information regarding the new courses introduced in MBA R24 Regulation was presented before the members. The committee appreciated for strictly adhering to the JNTUK guidelines. Members felt satisfied for introducing Artificial Intelligence as per the industry demand.
5. Members discussed the CO-PO attainments for the 2024 admitted batch under R23 Regulation and reviewed the attainment levels of various courses. Suitable action plans were suggested for courses where attainment levels were below targets. The committee also approved the CO-PO target levels proposed for all courses under R24 Regulation.
6. The syllabus for the following courses offered to B.Tech branches was presented and discussed:
 - o Management Science
 - o Human Resource and Project Management

Members suggested to discuss more case studies, practical examples, and activity-based learning components while delivering the course. The Board approved the syllabi of both the courses.

Committee suggested the faculty to apply for funding projects under different schemes for strengthening research. Members also felt that more training programmes are required for making students industry ready and also to get qualitative placements with better packages.
 10. Members discussed the events organized and attended by faculty and students during the A.Y. 2025–26, including seminars, workshops, guest lectures, industrial visits, conferences, FDPs, and student participation in management events. The committee appreciated the active involvement of faculty and students in academic and professional development activities.
 11. The proposed Calendar of Events for the A.Y. 2026–27 was presented before the committee. Members reviewed the schedule of academic, co-curricular, extracurricular, and professional development activities and approved the calendar of events.
 12. Other Points discussed:
 - Members suggested encouraging students to undertake interdisciplinary and innovative projects in collaboration with industries and entrepreneurs.
 - The committee recommended conducting more certification programs, mock interviews, industry expert talks, and skill-development sessions to enhance employability.
 - Members also advised the department to strengthen collaborations with industries and MoU organizations for internships, live projects, and research activities.
